**Caring Hearts—A February Collection**

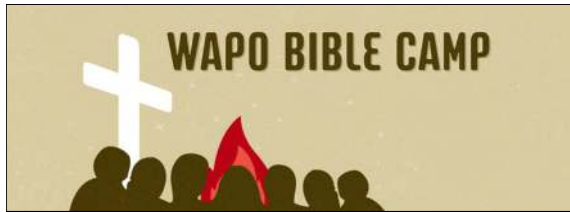
