**Masterworks for Spring 2020!**

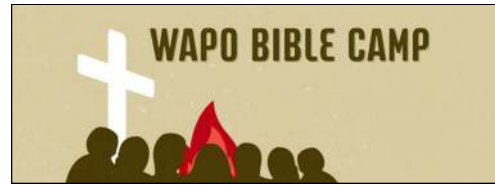
